

KINDERGARTEN SCREENING SEQUENCE

1. Teachers take the KOI Training as soon as it is available each year.
2. Teachers observe students and complete a KOI to help make the nomination decision.
3. If you have any questions about nominating a student, call Advanced Studies at 903-262-3498.
4. The kindergarten teacher will develop a screening file on the nominated student.
5. Product(s) showing advanced abilities is optional. If you choose to turn in any sample(s) of gifted work, do not send more than 2 pieces.
6. The deadline for all completed student files to be turned into Advanced Studies will be announced at a later date.
7. Kindergarten Spring Testing will be at TARGET. You will be notified of the date ahead of time.

KINDERGARTEN G/T Nominations & McGee Keiser Curriculum

- A. We train and ask that **kindergarten** teachers teach **McGee Keiser Wonders** to their GT talent pool students. You can use it with all students, however. And, **first grade** teachers **will use Patterns** with their GT students that are in their classes.
- B. Screening of possible kindergarten students who need services will take place in the spring each year. Then, the campus teacher will be required to use the McGee Keiser and curriculum differentiation in the regular classroom beginning no later than March 1 each year.
- C. Screening results will be reported to schools as soon as they are available.
