

APPROVED RATES OF PAY
FY 2010-2011

SUMMER AND EXTENDED DAY/WEEK PROGRAMS

School administrators may not receive compensation for planning for extended day/year programs. The salary schedule below reflects compensation for days worked outside of the administrative contract.

Professional employees will only be paid 8 hours per day maximum, for any day worked.

Program Administrator

Maximum of \$288 daily rate for an 8 hour day or \$36/hour

High School Records and Scheduling – Summer School

\$500 stipend for each summer session, maximum of \$1,000 for both
Limited to an employee who is not already in the records and scheduling position.

High School Counselor – Summer School

\$500 stipend for each summer session, maximum of \$1,000 for both
May begin work after regular contract has ended

Teachers – Summer School or Extended Day/Week

\$20/hour

Lead Teacher – Summer School or Extended Day/Week

\$23/hour

Librarian – Summer School or Extended Day/Week

\$20/hour

Registered Nurse – Summer School

\$20/hour

Interpreters – Summer School or Extended Day/Week

\$15/hour

Secretary – Summer School

\$12.50/hour

Attendance Clerk

\$10.50/hour

Aides

\$10/hour

School Bus Monitors

\$10/hour

Licensed Vocational Nurse

\$11/hour

Minimum Wage for clerical, child care, manual labor

PREPARATION FOR SUMMER AND EXTENDED DAY/WEEK PROGRAMS

When teachers/staff are paid for the expertise in a subject, such as curriculum writing or presenting to others, or to plan for lessons for students, the rate of pay is \$20/hour. Preparation for Summer School is \$20/hour.

TUTORING

Certified teachers - \$20/hour

Non-certified, bachelor's degree - \$15/hour

College or high school students - \$10/hour

TEACHING AN EXTRA CLASS DURING A CONFERENCE PERIOD

Teacher would be paid 1/6 of a beginning teacher's salary pro-rated for the number of days (of 177) the class is picked up. The funds would come from a district salary fund if there is a vacant position, or if student enrollment justifies an extra class, but not an additional teacher FTE. If the campus chooses to lower class sizes, the funds would come from the campus.
